

Topical Anthralin

Medication:

This compounded prescription you have received contains anthralin, which is used to treat psoriasis and keratolytic agent.

Use:

This medication is used to treat psoriasis

Directions:

FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY. Avoid contact with the eyes or mucous membranes. Do not apply on any areas that are not affected by condition. Do not overuse product. Clean and dry affected area before use. Apply a thin layer to the affected skin and gently rub in. Leave on skin for the directed amount of time before washing off. Discontinue use if sensitivity occurs or if excessive irritation develops. Wash hands thoroughly after use; consider using rubber gloves when applying.

Precautions:

MAY STAIN SKIN, NAILS, HAIR (temporarily) or FABRICS (permanently).

Apply sparingly and carefully to affected areas only. In order prevent the possibility of staining clothing or bed linens it maybe advisable to use protective dressings. To prevent the possibility of discoloration, always rinse the bath/shower with hot water immediately after washing/showering the bath or shower. Contact with fabrics, plastics and other materials may cause staining and should be avoided. Allow 1 week between the discontinuance of topical corticosteroids and this product.

Side Effects:

Burning, irritation or redness may occur. If severe, discontinue use and contact your physician.

Missed Dose:

It is important to take each dose as directed. If you miss a dose, take next dose as soon as possible. If almost time for the next dose, skip the missed dose and return to your regular schedule. Do not take a double dose or extra doses to catch up. DO NOT stop or change the dose of the medication without first consulting your healthcare provider.

Storage:

Store at room temperature. Avoid excessive heat.
