

Dyclonine Solution

Medication:

This compounded prescription you have received contains dyclonine.

Uses:

This medication is used as a topical anesthetic used to relieve pain associated with the mouth and throat.

Directions:

May be applied as a mouthwash or gargle and the excess spit out. May also be applied as a rinse, or swab to relieve the discomfort of aphthous stomatitis, herpetic stomatitis, or other painful oral lesions.

Side Effects:

The following adverse effects are usually dose related and may include: lightheadedness, nervousness, confusion dizziness, drowsiness, blurred vision, vomiting, sensations of cold or numbness, twitching, tremors, convulsions, respiratory depression and arrest. Alert healthcare provider of any allergic reactions associated with medication.

Precautions:

Tell your healthcare provider if symptoms last greater than 7 days. When treating a severe sore throat, patients should contact healthcare provider if symptoms lasts greater than 2 days, occur with fever, headache, rash, nausea, or vomiting.

Missed Dose:

Take missed dose as soon as possible. If it is almost time for the next dose, skip the missed dose and resume your regular schedule. Do not “double up” on dose or take extra doses. Many times this medication is taken on an as needed basis.

Storage:

Store at room temperature.
